

Trophy Bull Elk Tag Raffle

On the Nature Conservancy's Zumwalt Prairie Preserve To Benefit the Enterprise-Joseph Lions Club



Thank you for your interest in purchasing a Guided Hunt with a Landowner Preference (LOP) Tag for a **Trophy Bull Elk Hunt** on the Nature Conservancy's 33,000 acre Zumwalt Prairie Preserve (for a Fall 2021 hunt) in NE Oregon. The funds raised are going to help the Enterprise/Joseph Lions Club:

- 1) implement a local Diabetes Prevention Program with Wallowa County Healthcare Providers &
- 2) create a "Ski Bus" to provide transportation to Ferguson Ridge Ski Area in Joseph, OR for those who are otherwise unable to get there.

The Enterprise-Joseph Lions Club will be selling 100 tickets for \$100 each. Individuals can purchase as many tickets as they would like on a first come, first serve basis. The drawing will be held sometime between Feb 1, 2021 and March 31, 2021 for a hunt in the Fall of 2021. We will hold a live raffle drawing online for all of those interested in watching.

After tickets are purchased we will email you with confirmation and your raffle ticket numbers.

Notes about what winner will receive

- This raffle provides 1 LOP tag of the 4 trophy bull tags available on the Zumwalt Prairie Preserve for the Fall 2021 season. This does not provide an “exclusive” hunting opportunity, as there will be multiple hunters in the 2021 season.
- Each LOP tag holder is entitled to a 3-day guided hunt on the Zumwalt Prairie Preserve.
- Each hunter will have his/her own guide contracted by TNC. Hunters must be accompanied by the guide at all times.
- Hunters are responsible for the costs of their hunting license, tag fee and tip for the guide should they choose to give one.
- Hunters are allowed to bring up to 2 guests with them during their hunt.
- The property contains steep slopes and can be physically challenging to hunt successfully.
- There is no vehicle traffic off of established roads. Harvested animals must be packed to an established road.

The Nature Conservancy has generously donated this LOP hunting tag to the Enterprise/Joseph Lions Club. We are excited to provide this opportunity and to put the funds raised to work in our community.
